

How to use an FC fiber optic interface



Overview

The Fibre Channel physical layer is based on serial connections that use fiber optics to copper between corresponding pluggable modules. The modules may have a single lane, dual lanes or quad lanes that correspond to the SFP, SFP-DD and QSFP form factors. Fibre Channel does not use 8- or 16-lane modules (like CFP8, QSFP-DD, or COBO used in 400GbE) and there are no plans to use these expensive and comple.

- Coupling nut:** Screws onto the port to secure the connection.

Steps to Connect an FC Interface

Inspect the Connector and Port: Ensure both the FC connector and the port are clean and free of dust or debris. Use a fiber optic cleaning kit if necessary to prevent signal loss or damage.

Align the Ferrule: Position the ferrule so that the fiber core aligns with the receiving port. Proper alignment is critical to maintain low insertion loss and optimal return loss .

Insert the Connector: Gently insert the FC connector into the port. Do not force it, as misalignment can damage the fiber.

Secure with the Screw Coupling Nut: Rotate the coupling nut clockwise until it is firmly tightened. This screw-on mechanism ensures the connector remains stable even in high-vibration environments .
