Fusion Splicing: Join incoming fibers to pigtail terminations inside the FDB using a fusion splicer, ensuring minimal signal loss. Routing and Slack Management: Maintain gentle bends and avoid sharp turns to prevent fiber breakage. Leave service loops for future maintenance, typically about 100 feet per 1,000 feet of cable, and add loops at street crossings. Segregate fiber from heavy copper cables to avoid crush loads and bend radius violations. Environmental Protection: Seal gel-fill...
