

How to wire an external socket in a distribution box

AI Overview

To wire an external socket from a distribution box, use a dedicated RCD-protected circuit with appropriate MCBs, SWA cable for outdoor runs, and ensure proper earthing and IP-rated socket installation. Planning and Safety When wiring an external socket, safety is paramount. The socket must be IP66 rated to resist water and dust, and it must be protected by a 30mA RCD either in the consumer unit or built into the socket itself. A dedicated circuit is recommended to avoid overloading existing circuits and to provide double protection in case of faults.

Distribution Box Connections

Main Supply to DB: Connect the incoming phase and neutral from the main supply to the main MCB in the distribution box.

RCCB/RCD Protection: From the main MCB, connect the phase and neutral to an RCCB (Residual Current Circuit Breaker) to protect against leakage currents.

Sub-Circuit MCB: Connect the output of the RCCB to a single-pole or double-pole MCB for the external socket circuit. The MCB rating should match the expected load, typically 16A for a standard outdoor socket.

Neutral and Earth: Connect the neutral wire to the neutral bus bar and the earth wire to the earth bus bar in the distribution box. Ensure the metallic body of the socket and any conduit is properly earthed.

Cable Selection and Routing

Use SWA (Steel Wire Armoured) cable for any external runs to protect against mechanical damage and weather. Ensure the cable size is adequate for the load; for a 16A socket, 2.5mm² copper cable is typically sufficient for short runs, but longer distances may require larger cross-section. Route the cable neatly, avoiding sharp bends, and secure it with appropriate clips or conduits.

Socket Installation

Install the socket at a convenient height, typically 1–1.5 meters above ground, in a dry, accessible location. Ensure the socket cover closes properly to maintain the IP rating. Test the circuit wi...
