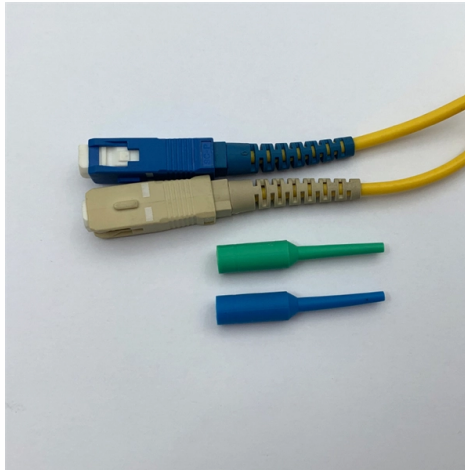


How to wire the outdoor distribution box
