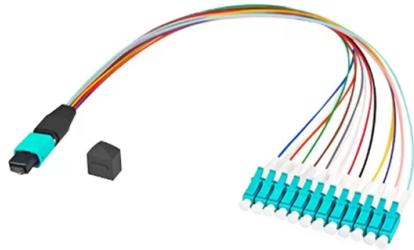


# Indoor Cable Tray Fabrication

- Site Preparation**Inspect the workspace to ensure safety and accessibility ( ). Install safety barriers and warning signs to protect workers. Coordinate with other trades to avoid interference during installation ( ).
- Support and Hanger Installation**Determine support spacing: typically 1.5–3 meters horizontally and no more than 2 meters vertically ( ). Use appropriate hangers, brackets, or threaded rods to secure trays. For long spans, add expansion joints to accommodate building movement ( ).
- Tray Assembly and Mounting**Assemble trays according to manufacturer instructions and approved drawings ( ). Ensure proper alignment, level, and secure connections between sections. Maintain minimum bend radius for cables at tray exits to prevent damage ( ).
- Cable Laying and Management**Identify each tray by feeder name and branch number ( ). Lay cables without exceeding the maximum fill capacity to prevent overheating ( ). Use cable ties or clamps at rungs or tray edges to secure cables while...
