5. **Optional Additional Grounding** For metal enclosures, attach a ground wire from the box's threaded studs to the mounting plate, and from the mounting plate to the central grounding point if required. This can reduce resistance and improve safety in complex installations.
6. **Test the Grounding System** After completing all connections, measure the resistance between the distribution box and the grounding electrode. Ensure it meets the required standard to guarantee effecti...
