For example, RS cable trays with a 60 mm edge height are used in widths from 100 to 300 mm, with couplers and brackets designed to maintain structural integrity. Ceiling suspension can be achieved using M10 threaded rods, TKS pendant brackets, or cantilever brackets with appropriate adapters.

Prepare Tools and Equipment: Ensure all tools comply with contract requirements and are suitable for galvanized steel installation.

Assemble Supports: Install ceiling, wall, or floor supports according to the standard support construction, ensuring proper alignment and spacing.

Install Cable Trays: Place trays on supports, connect sections using couplers, and secure with bolts or clamps. Ensure trays are level and properly aligned.

Check Load and Clearance: Verify that the trays can support the intended cable weight and maintain required c...
