- Busbars:** Distribute power from the main switch to each breaker.
- Neutral and earth bars:** Provide proper grounding and complete circuits.
- DIN rails and cable entry points:** Facilitate mounting additional devices and neat wiring.

Ensure each circuit has its own breaker or fuse, and include surge protection for sensitive appliances.

Wiring and Connections Follow color coding standards: line to line, neutral to neutral, ground to ground. Use the correct wire gauge for each circuit to prevent overheating. Strip insulation carefully and secure wires tightly to terminals to avoid loose connections. Route wires neatly...
