

Installation height of large distribution box

Mobile enclosures may be installed as low as 0.6 meters if necessary, but not exceeding 1.5 meters.

Consistency and Tolerances Within the same project or building, installation height should be consistent for all similar boxes, with allowable deviations typically within 10 millimeters.

Vertical alignment tolerances: For boxes less than 50 cm tall, deviation should not exceed 1.5 mm; for boxes 50 cm or taller, deviation should not exceed 3 mm.

Placement Considerations Install in dry, well-ventilated, and easily accessible areas. Avoid wet locations, corrosive environments, or areas prone to impact, vibration, or heat sources. Maintain sufficient operating space around the box, ideally enough for two people to work simultaneously, and ensure horizontal distances to controlled equipment are within recommended limits (e.g., switch boxes within 30 meters, controlled equipment within 3 meters).

Ensure proper cable entry and exit, smooth holes, and secure conduit connections to prevent exposure of internal wires...
