Attach Brackets: Secure the cantilever or monitoring bracket to the wall or ceiling support. For ceiling suspension, install threaded rods and a Unistrut channel to create a horizontal shelf for the tray.

Place and Secure Trays: Lift the cable tray sections onto the brackets. Use hold-down clips or bolts to fasten the tray securely, preventing movement. Join tray sections end-to-end with couplers.

Adjust and Inspect: Ensure the tray is level and properly aligned. Verify that all fasteners are tight and that the installation meets load requirements and safety standards, including IEC 60364, IEEE, or local electrical codes.
