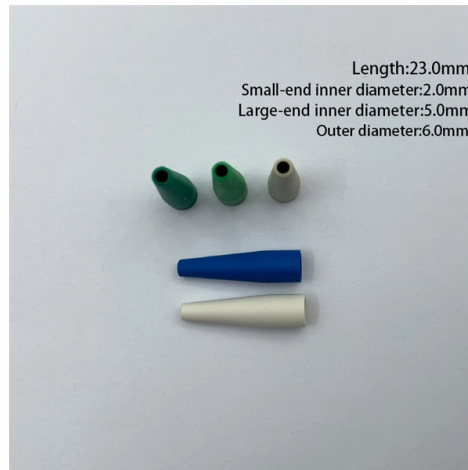


Installation of Electrical Distribution Box for Electric Guardrails
