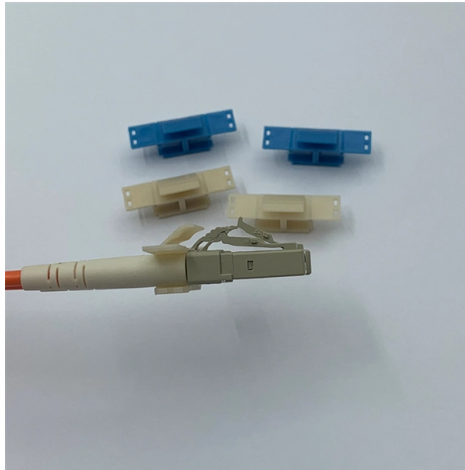

Cable Protection and Handling Maintain protective sheathing on the cable until installation is complete. Avoid sharp bends, turn-backs, or pulling over edges to prevent fiber breakage. Use figure-8 loops when laying cable on the surface to prevent twisting.

Post-Installation Checks Inspect the installed cable for mechanical stress, bends, or damage. Verify depth and alignment according to design specifications. Perform testing for signal integrity and continuity before final backfilling or covering.
