Material Selection and Environmental Considerations Cable tray supports are typically made from steel, stainless steel, aluminum, or FRP, with finishes or galvanization applied to resist corrosion and environmental degradation. Material choice depends on ambient conditions, load requirements, and exposure to moisture, chemicals, or sunlight. Aluminum is preferred for its corrosion resistance, while steel provides higher mechanical strength.
