

Installation of electrical cabinet wiring

Ensure all connections are made inside an electrical box; wire nuts alone without a box are not code-compliant for exposed wiring. Test the outlet or fixture with a voltage tester before restoring power.

Additional Tips

For under-cabinet lighting, consider low-voltage LED systems with a transformer to reduce heat and simplify wiring. Keep wiring concealed and organized to maintain aesthetics and allow easy maintenance. Use raceways or conduit if necessary for exposed runs. Al...
