

Installing the QSFP-DD optical module



AI Overview

QSFP-DD Active Optical Modules can be safely installed by following ESD precautions, proper orientation, and careful seating into the transceiver port while keeping dust plugs in place until fiber connection.

Preparation and Safety

- ESD Protection:** Always wear an ESD wrist strap and connect it to a grounded point on the chassis or rack to prevent electrostatic discharge damage to the module.
- Work Area:** Use an antistatic mat or foam to place the module when not in the port.
- Temperature Considerations:** Ensure the module is within a safe handling temperature range; metal surfaces can exceed 55°C during operation.
- Dust Plugs:** Keep dust plugs on the optical ports until ready to connect fiber to prevent contamination.

Installation Procedure

- Remove the Module from Packaging:** Take the QSFP-DD module out of its protective bag, avoiding contact with electrical connector pins.
- Remove Port Dust Cover:** If the device port has a dust cover, remove it and save it for future use.
- Orient the Module:** Align the module with the port so that the connector faces the correct direction. QSFP-DD modules have a pull-tab latch or bail latch for secure insertion.
- Insert the Module:** Slide the module gently into the port until the locking pins engage. Press firmly on the front of the module to ensure it is fully seated.
- Verify Installation:** Check that the module is flush with the port and the latch is engaged. If the module is hot-swapped, wait at least 10 seconds after removing the previous module before inserting the new one.
- Fiber Connection:** Only remove the dust plug from the optical port when ready to attach the fiber cable. Align the fiber connector with the optical bore; the design prevents incorrect orientation. Insert the fiber gently until it clicks or seats fully.

Maintenance and Handling Tips

- Avoid repeated insertion and removal; QSFP-DD modules are rated for 500-2000 cycles.
- Always use dust caps on unused ports to prevent contamination.
- Handle the module by the pull tab or label, avoiding contact with the metal body or electrical connectors.
- Clean fiber connectors before installati...
