

Interconnection of multiple gigabit switches via optical ports

This method is cost-effective for short distances (up to 100 meters) and is ideal when connecting a copper-based switch to an SFP port .Connecting via Optical SFP Module Choose the appropriate optical SFP module for your fiber type (single-mode or multi-mode) and wavelength. Ensure it matches the specifications of the other end .Insert the optical SFP module into the SFP port, following the alignment key to avoid damage .Remove dust caps from both the SFP module and fiber connectors, then clean the fiber end-faces with lint-free wipes and isopropyl alcohol .Connect the fiber optic patch cord to the SFP module, ensuring proper alignment and secure seating. Check the link status to confirm a successful connection. Optical SFP modules are preferred for longer distances or when connecting switches across different buildings or data centers .S...
