- 5. Compatibility with Fiber:** Fiber internet uses an ONT instead of a traditional modem, so your router must be compatible with fiber connections. Cable or DSL routers may not support the required WAN interface or speed.
- 6. Device and Coverage Considerations:** Ensure the router can handle the number of devices in your home or office. Consider coverage area; routers with multiple antennas or mesh capabilities can provide consistent speeds throughout your space.

- Wired connections are generally faster and more reliable than wireless for achieving full 1000 Mbps speeds.
- Keep your router firmware updated to maintain performance and security.
