

Is it okay to plug fiber optic cables into a switch

Direct Attach Cables (DACs): For short distances, pre-terminated DACs with SFP modules on each end can simplify installation and reduce cost while maintaining high performance . Switch configuration: After physically connecting the fiber, configure the switch ports to match the transceiver's speed, duplex mode, and flow control settings. Link aggregation can be used to increase bandwidth and redundancy if multiple fiber links are deployed .
