

Is it permissible to install on the side of a distribution box



Overview

Round boxes cannot be used where raceways or connectors requiring locknuts or bushings attach to the side of the box. NEC Article 314 establishes requirements for the installation and use of electrical boxes, conduit bodies, fittings, and handhole enclosures. A conduit body is a removable-cover section of a conduit system that provides access at junctions or termination points. This placement facilitates securing. The NEC (National Electric Code) does allow an electric panel to be mounted horizontally, but only if vertical mounting is not possible due to space limitations or otherwise impractical (NEC 240). Unfortunately, a second code requirement is that when circuit breakers are mounted in a vertical. Choose the right box based on environment (indoor/outdoor), load capacity, and durability. Check for proper IP/NEMA ratings and material quality. Non-compliance risks safety or code violations. Installers also have to follow rules for box fill.
