It is important to get a square cut to ensure a good splice connection. Cable tray manufacturers offer jigs and other devices to aid in field cutting. After cutting, smooth the cut edges to remove any burrs. Fiberglass material should be cut with a circular saw with a carbide tip or a diamond. The bending radius of a cable describes the minimum arc created along the cable's centerline during a bend.
