 - Cable Management:** Use proper routing and support to enhance longevity and performance, including securing cables in conduits or trays and avoiding sharp edges.
- 4. Underground or Aerial Installation**
 - Underground:** Cables are usually pulled through buried conduits at depths of 1-1.2 meters, with marker tape above for future detection. Directional boring may be used to avoid surface disruption.
 - Aerial:** If relocating along poles, ensure proper attachment and tensioning to prevent sagging...
