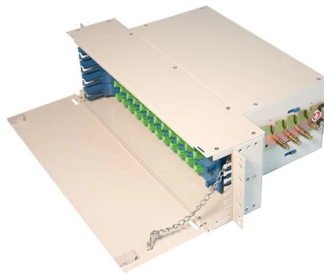

Maintain secure grounding and earthing for the metal enclosure, electrical boards, and connected appliances. Install residual current devices (RCDs) or leakage protectors for additional safety.

Standards Compliance: Follow IEC 60364, IEC 61439, NEC, BS 7671, or local codes depending on jurisdiction. Use UL, CE, or VDE-certified components to ensure compliance and safety. In Germany, DIN VDE 0100 series standards apply, including protection against electric shock (VDE 0100-410), thermal effects (VDE 0100-420), and testing (VDE 0100-600).
