- 1. Firewalls** Firewalls are typically placed at the network perimeter between internal networks and the Internet. They monitor and control incoming and outgoing traffic based on predefined rules, blocking unauthorized access and filtering malicious traffic. Network-based IDS (NIDS) monitors all traffic across the network, whereas host-based IDS (HIDS) focuses on individual devices.
- 3. Virtual Private Network (VPN) Gateways** VPN gateways are positioned at network entry points to provide secure remote access. They encrypt data transmitted between remote users and the internal network, ensuring confidentiality and protection against interception.
- 4. Network Access Control (NAC)** NAC devices are deployed at network access points, such as switches or wireless access points, to enforce security policies. They ensure that only authorized devices and users can connect to the network, blocking non-compliant or untrusted devices.
- 5. Unified Threat Management (UTM) Appliances** UTM devices combine multiple security functions—firewall, antivirus, anti-spam, content filtering, and IPS—into a single appliance. They are often placed at the network perimeter to provide comprehensive...
