The main switch in a distribution box isolates the incoming supply and feeds protective devices like MCBs, RCDs, or RCBOs, ensuring safe power distribution to all circuits.

Main Switch Function and Selection The main switch serves as the primary isolator for the distribution box, allowing complete disconnection of power for maintenance or emergency purposes. In small residential boards, this is typically a double-pole switch for single-phase systems, while three-phase boards use a four-pole switch disconnecter or MCCB. Key selection points include:

- Rated current matching the total load of the installation.
- Short-circuit capacity suitable for the incoming supply.
- Isolation capability; note that a switch disconnecter may not provide overcurrent protection unless specifically rated for it.

Wiring Sequence Proper wiring ensures safety and compliance:

- Incoming Supply Connection:** Connect the phase (L) and neutral (N) wires from the supply to the input terminals of the main switch.
- Output to Protective Devices:** The output of the main switch feeds the RCD or RCCB if residual-current protection is required. For setups using RCBOs, the main switch output connects directly to the busbar feeding individual RCBOs.
- MCB Connections:** For double-pole MCBs, connect both phase and neutral from the RCD output to the MCB input. For single-pole MCBs, connect only the phase wire from the RCD output to the MCB input; the neutral connects to the neutral bar.
- Earth and Neutral Bars:** Connect the earth wire from the supply to the earth bar and the neutral wire to the neutral bar. All outgoing circuits' neutrals and earths are also connected here.

Protective Device Strategy MCBs protect individual circuits against overload and short-circuit currents. RCDs/RCCBs detect earth leakage and prevent electric shocks. RCBOs combine overcurrent and residual-current protection for each circuit,...
