- RCCB/RCD:** Provides earth fault protection, usually rated at 30mA for domestic safety.

Ensure Proper Coordination The main switch should handle the total load, while branch MCBs protect individual circuits. The switch ratings must be coordinated to prevent nuisance tripping and ensure selective protection. For example, the main MCB rating should exceed the sum of branch MCB ratings but remain within the conductor's safe limit.

Organize Layout and Wiring Use busbars or comb-type connections to distribute power efficiently to branch MCBs. Maintain clear labeling, terminal numbering, and color coding for easy maintenance and troubleshooting. Ensure that the wiring diagram reflects the actual switch configuration and protective devices.
