Pigtailing, or parallel wiring, is the preferred method for reliability. This technique involves splicing the incoming wire, the outgoing wire, and a short piece of wire called a pigtail together using a wire nut inside the electrical box. This connection method has a proprietary name in the distribution box-jumper. In order to better let everyone understand "jumper", let's take a look at a photo. Modern residential wiring uses three types of conductors, each with a specific role in the circuit: Hot wires (typically black or red insulation) carry current from the source to the device.
