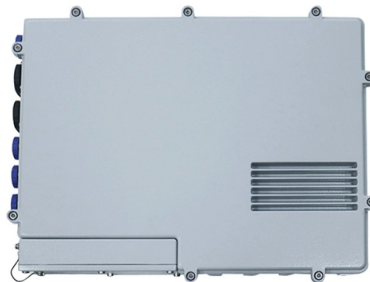

For high-throughput mobile or edge deployments, Terabit-class edge routers with 400Gbit/s interfaces can scale capacity without increasing space or power requirements, making them suitable for mobile cabinet installations.
