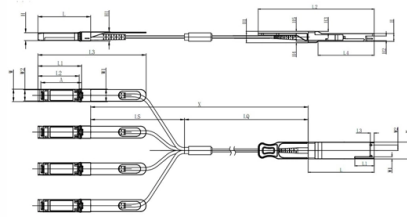

All fiber optic ports, such as 100BASE-FX ports, operate only at one preset speed and are always full-duplex. Use the Syntax Checker in Figure 2 to configure port F0/1 of switch S1.

Configuring Switch Port Speed and Duplex Setting

Auto-negotiation determines the port speed and duplex setting for each port (except 10 and 40 Gbps ports). You can manually configure the duplex setting and the speed of 10/100/1000 Mbps ports.
