Network Rack: A physical frame or cabinet that holds the equipment inside an IDF. In other words, an IDF may contain one or more network racks, but a rack by itself does not constitute an IDF. The IDF is defined by its role in the network hierarchy and its connectivity functions, not just by the presence of a rack .
