OS2 is a single-mode optical fiber designed for long-distance, high-speed transmission with low attenuation and high bandwidth.

Core Characteristics OS2 fibers are single-mode fibers (SMF) with a core diameter of approximately 8–9 microns, optimized to transmit a single light mode, which minimizes modal dispersion and allows long-distance communication. They are suitable for telecom backbones, LAN/WAN backbones, and fiber-to-the-home or business applications.

Attenuation and Wavelength OS2 fibers provide low signal attenuation, typically around 0.4 dB/km at 1310 nm and 0.3 dB/km at 1550 nm, ensuring minimal signal loss over long distances. They operate effectively across the 1250–1625 nm spectrum, covering O, E, S, C, and L bands for future bandwidth expansion. The fibers are compatible with legacy single-mode fibers, reducing splice loss and improving splice yield.

Standards Compliance OS2 fibers meet or exceed multiple international standards, including: ITU-T G.652D and G.657A1 for low bending sensitivity and reduced macro bending loss; IEC 60793-2-50; ISO 11801 OS2; TIA-492-CA; and Btelcordia GR-20.

Performance and Distance OS2 fibers support high-speed transmission: Up to 100 Gbps over 10 km at 1310 nm; Up to 40 km for 10 Gbps; Up to 80 km for 1 Gbps. Long-haul links can reach 200 km for 1 Gbps with proper amplification.

Mechanical and Environmental Features OS2 cables are available in loose tube or tight-buffered constructions, suitable for indoor and outdoor installations, including ducts, trays, aerial, and direct burial. They often feature LSZH sheathing, high tensile strength, and rodent protection. Low macro bend-insensitive fibers allow reduced bending radii, maintaining performance in tight installations.
