- Receiver Optical Sub-Assembly (ROSA):** Converts incoming optical signals back into electrical signals. It contains a photodetector (PIN or avalanche photodiode), a trans-impedance amplifier (TIA), and a post-amplifier to produce a digital signal suitable for processing.
- Automatic Power Control (APC):** Maintains consistent optical output power to ensure reliable transmission.

Types of Optical Modules

- SFP/SFP+:** Small form-factor pluggable modules for 1-10 Gbps transmission.
- SFP28:** Supports 25 Gbps.
- QSFP/QSFP+:** Quad small form-factor pluggable modules for 40-100 Gbps.
- QSFP28:** Supports 100 Gbps or higher.
- CFP:** Centum form-factor pluggable for high-speed telecom applications.

Modules are also classified by fiber type:

- Single-mode modules:** For long-distance, high-bandwidth transmission.
- Multimode modules:** For short-distance, lower-cost ap...
