

PoE switch network cascading



AI Overview

PoE switch cascading allows multiple switches to be connected in series to extend network coverage and power delivery, but it requires careful planning of ports, cable types, and network topology.

What is Cascading? Cascading is the process of connecting one switch to another to expand the network. Each switch in a cascade operates independently, passing data and power to connected devices. This is different from stacking, where multiple switches are connected via dedicated stacking ports and managed as a single logical unit. Cascading is cost-effective and simple, making it suitable for small to medium networks, such as CCTV setups or office networks.

Methods of Cascading

- Uplink Port Cascading:** Use the switch's dedicated UPLINK port to connect to another switch. Requires a straight-through Ethernet cable. Maximum cable length per segment is 100 meters. Typically, up to 5 levels of switches can be cascaded before performance issues arise.
- Normal Port Cascading:** Connect standard Ethernet ports between switches. May require crossover wiring (pins 1-3 and 2-6 switched) depending on switch models. Useful when uplink ports are unavailable.

Considerations for PoE

- Power Budget:** Each PoE switch has a maximum power output. Cascading multiple switches can reduce the available power per device if the upstream switch cannot supply enough power to downstream switches.
- Cable Type:** For Gigabit PoE, all four pairs of a CAT5e or CAT6 cable are used for data and power via phantom power, so proper cabling is essential.
- Distance Limitations:** Standard Ethernet limits each segment to 100 meters. Cascading can extend coverage but may require additional switches or fiber links for longer distances.
- Topology Tips**
 - Linear (Daisy Chain):** Connect switches in series (A → B → C). Works well for up to three switches but lacks redundancy. A single switch failure can disrupt the network.
 - Star or Circular Topology:** Provides redundancy and two-way data paths, reducing the risk of network failure, but may introduce loops and require...
