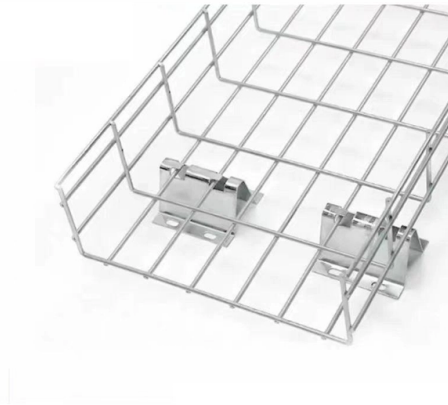


Power Distribution Box Jumper Wiring

Wiring Jumpers

Select the Correct Jumper Type: Use terminal block jumpers for connecting multiple terminals or circuit breaker jumpers for MCBs. Ensure the jumper is rated for the current and fits the specific terminal spacing.

Cut and Adjust Length: Trim the jumper to span only the terminals you need to connect. Remove any excess pins or material to avoid short circuits.

Connect to Terminal Blocks: Insert the jumper into the designated slots on the terminal blocks or MCBs. Push firmly to ensure a secure connection.

Phase Distribution: Connect the output of the main MCB to the input of the RCCB (if used), then use jumpers to distribute the phase wire to each SP MCB or both phase and neutral to DP MCBs.

Neutral Distribution: Connect the neutral output from the RCCB to the neutral link. Use jumpers to connect the neutral link to each SP MCB or load as required.

Earth Connection: Connect the earth wire from the supply to the earth bar. Use jumpers if needed to connect multiple earth points for all loads.

Final Steps

- Check Connections:** Ensure all jumpers are properly seated, and wires are securely tightened.
- Organize Wires:** Use cable ties to keep wires neat and prevent strain on terminals.
- Label Circuits:** Mark each circuit for easy identification and maintenance.
- Test the System:** After wiring, restore power and test each circuit...
