Neutral and phase lines (L1, L2, L3) are connected sequentially, often using mechanically keyed connectors to prevent miswiring ().

Single-Phase vs Three-Phase: Single-phase distribution boxes typically include a main double-pole MCB or switch, with single-pole MCBs for individual loads and an RCCB for protection against leakage currents (). Three-phase boxes use separate terminals for each phase, allowing balanced load distribution and connection to multiple outgoing circuits.

Potential Distribution Blocks

DIN Rail Power Distribution Blocks: These blocks allow multiple copper or aluminum conductors to be connected safely, providing a compact and high-density wiring solution (). They are finger-safe, short-circuit resistant, and can be cross-connected using flat copper bridges to increase outgoing connection points ().

Push-In and Screw Terminal Blocks: Systems like PTFIX blocks enable quick, maintenance-free connections with color-coded terminals for clear identification (). They support various conductor sizes and can be extended or combined for flexible potential distribution.

Voltage Regulation: Some PDBs include voltage regulators to protect sensitive equipment from overvoltage, especially in solar or battery-powered systems ().

Load Capacity: Ensure that each output does not exceed the rated current of the PDB or connected MCBs.
