- Boosting internet penetration, which was 17.4% in early 2022, aiming to improve access for telecom operators, banks, insurance companies, schools, and hospitals.
- Completion scheduled by December 2024, with energy-efficient systems and monitoring facilities to support public and private sector data hosting.

Regional Fibre Optic Backbone The DRC is also part of a 10,000 km regional fibre-optic backbone project spanning five countries: DRC, Zambia, Zimbabwe, Malawi, and Mozambique. Key features include:

- Connecting up to 3,000 schools, 1,500 hospitals, and 1,200 government institutions, significantly improving access to digital services.
- Providing coverage to previously unconnected areas, enhancing quality of service and regional connectivity.
- Supporting metro networks and backbone infrastructure to strengthen Central and Southern Africa's digital ecosystem.
