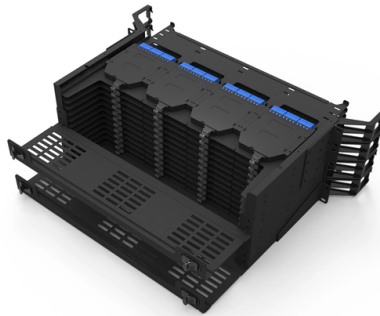

This ensures flame propagation, smoke emission, and heat release are controlled in case of fire. Mounting and Installation Practices Cable trays should be securely mounted to ceilings, walls, or floors using appropriate clamps, brackets, and supports. Long spans (3–6 meters) require stable construction with proper couplings and lid clamps to maintain rigidity and electrical continuity. Flexible dividers and rounded form pieces help maintain cable separation and prevent interference between power and data cables.
