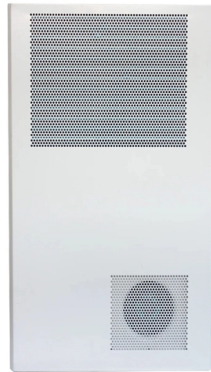


Requirements for Emergency Inspection of Distribution Boxes
