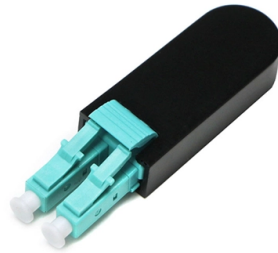


Requirements for Installing Electrical Distribution Boxes in Homes

Location and Accessibility The distribution box should be installed in a dry, well-ventilated area that is easily accessible for maintenance and emergency shut-off. The recommended mounting height is typically around 1.5 meters (5 feet) from the floor, with a working clearance of at least 30 inches wide, 36 inches deep, and 6.5 feet high in front of the panel to comply with NEC 110.26 requirements. Enclosure and Protection Choose a box with the appropriate IP or NEMA rating based on indoor or outdoor use. Steel enclosures are durable for harsh environments, while plastic is suitable for indoor residential setups. The enclosure protects internal components from dust, moisture, and physical damage. Ensure the door can open fully (90°) and that the box has dedicated space for wiring and future upgrades.

Components and Wiring Inside the distribution box, include:

- Main breaker to control overall power supply
- Circuit breakers or fuses for individual circuits
- Bus bars to distribute power from the main breaker to branch circuits
- Grounding bar for safe dissipation of stray currents

Use proper wire gauge for each circuit, secure all connections, and maintain neat cable management. Ensure correct insulation and secure grounding to prevent electrical hazards. Each circuit should have its own protective device, and surge protection is recommended for sensitive electronics.
