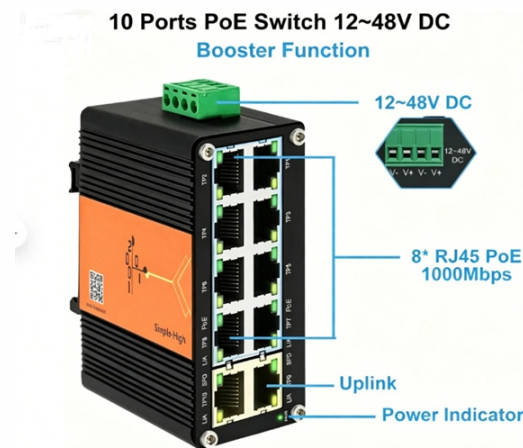

Component Layout: Inside the box, components such as circuit breakers, residual current devices (RCDs), busbars, terminal blocks, and wiring should be arranged for safe, reliable, and easy maintenance.

Each lighting circuit should have its own breaker, and RCDs are mandatory in damp or outdoor areas to protect against electric shock.

Circuit Protection: Include appropriate protective devices: Circuit breakers (LS switches) for overload and short-circuit protection. Residual current devices (RCDs) for leakage current protection. Surge protectors if required for sensitive lighting equipment.

Wiring and Connections: Use proper wire gauges, secure grounding, and neat cable management. Ensure all terminals are clearly labeled, and maintain separation between circuits, especially when different voltages or control systems are involved.

Installation Guidelines Placement: Install the box in a dry, accessible, and ventilated area, typically at a height of around 1.5 meters. Avoid locations prone to water ingress or mechanical damage.

Mounting: Wall-mounted boxes should be securely fixed.
