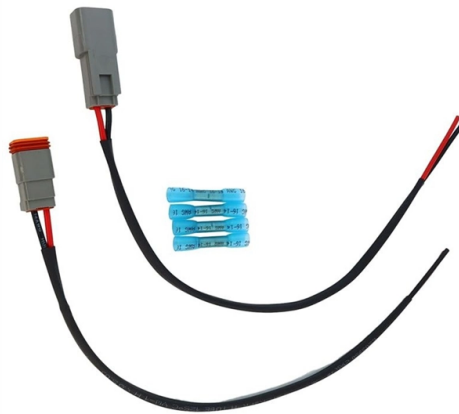


Revit cable tray labeling



AI Overview

Cable tray markings in Revit are controlled through the Cable Tray Settings pane, type properties, and view filters to manage size, connectors, and visual annotations.

Cable Tray Settings Pane The Cable Tray Settings pane allows you to configure how cable trays are displayed and annotated in your project :

- Use Annot. Scale for Single Line Fittings:** Determines whether fittings are drawn according to the Cable Tray Fitting Annotation Size parameter. Changing this does not affect already placed components.
- Cable Tray Fitting Annotation Size:** Sets the plotted size of fittings in single-line views, independent of drawing scale.
- Cable Tray Size Separator:** Defines the symbol used to separate width and height in size notation (e.g., 12" x 4").
- Cable Tray Size Suffix:** Adds a symbol or text after the size for clarity.
- Cable Tray Connector Separator:** Specifies the symbol used between two different connectors. These settings ensure that cable tray sizes and fittings are consistently annotated across views.

Type Properties and Routing Preferences When editing a cable tray type, you can configure routing preferences and fittings :

- Width, Height, Offset, Bend Radius:** Automatically calculated but can be adjusted for specific project needs.
- Fittings:** Assign vertical inside/outside bends, tees, crosses, reducers, and unions. Properly loading fitting families ensures accurate automatic generation when trays change direction.
- Routing Preferences:** Define how cable trays connect and transition, which affects the visual representation and annotation in plans.

Visual Differentiation and Marking To differentiate cable trays in views or documentation, Revit provides several options :

- View Filters:** Create filters based on system type, size, or other parameters, and assign hatch patterns, colors, or line styles to visually mark different trays.
- Phases:** Use phases to indicate installation stages or highlight specific trays, adjusting graphics per phase.
- Filled Regions:** Manually hatch trays for custom visual representation, though this is more time-consuming.
