

Senegal New Energy Internet



Overview

Starlink's satellite internet service is now operational in Senegal, supporting the country's efforts to expand nationwide digital access. The launch contributes to Senegal's goal of extending connectivity to remote and underserved areas and connecting one million citizens by the end. The launch of the Renewable Energy and Energy Efficiency Fund (REEF) marked a significant moment in Senegal's pursuit of a just and inclusive energy transition. The event, held during the Forum Invest in Diamniadio, brought together senior government officials, development partners, and private. With a national electricity access rate of 84%, Senegal is making progress towards universal energy access, yet more than 30 % of rural communities remain disconnected from the grid. By. Senegal has signed two key agreements with Chinese state-owned firm CNTIC to boost its solar energy and digital infrastructure. The deal includes the construction of two 50 MWp photovoltaic solar power plants, each paired with a 30 MW / 90 MWh battery storage system, to support the country's rural. The Just Energy Transition Partnerships (JETPs) bring donor countries together with ambitious emerging and developing countries to achieve the 1.5°C target of the Paris Agreement.
