OSFP Connectors in OLTs OSFP (Octal Small Form Factor Pluggable) connectors are high-speed pluggable modules that support aggregate data rates from 200 Gbps up to 1.6 Tbps, making them suitable for modern OLT backplanes and data center interconnects . OSFP modules support advanced signaling standards such as 28G NRZ, 56G PAM4, 112G PAM4, and 224G PAM4, and include integrated thermal management to maintain signal integrity at high speeds . In OLT applications, OSFP modules can be used for high-bandwidth uplinks or interconnects between OLT line cards and aggregation switches, enabling service providers to scale their networks while maintaining low latency and high reliability .
