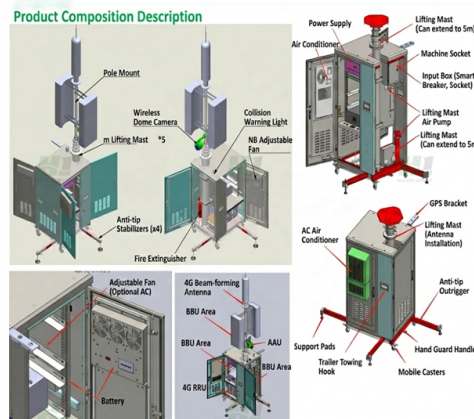


Setting up a wireless router with a static IP address for fiber optic broadband



AI Overview

You can set up a wireless router with a static IP over fiber by connecting the fiber to an ONT, linking it to your router, and configuring the router's WAN interface with the static IP, subnet mask, and gateway.

Step 1: Connect the Fiber Optic Cable Install the Optical Network Terminal (ONT) provided by your ISP at the fiber wall outlet. Connect the fiber optic cable from the wall outlet to the ONT's designated port (usually SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors) and power on the ONT. Wait 2–5 minutes for the status lights to stabilize. Link the ONT to your router using an Ethernet cable from the ONT's LAN/Ethernet port to the router's WAN port. Power on the router and confirm connectivity via indicator lights.

Step 2: Access Router Settings Open a web browser and enter your router's default IP address (commonly 192.168.0.1 or 192.168.1.1). Log in with the router's username and password (default is often admin/admin unless changed).

Step 3: Configure Static IP Navigate to Network Settings or WAN Settings. Disable DHCP for the WAN interface if it is enabled. Select Static IP and enter the following parameters:

- IP Address:** The static IP assigned by your ISP.
- Subnet Mask:** Provided by your ISP (e.g., 255.255.255.240 for a /28 block).
- Default Gateway:** The gateway IP provided by your ISP.

Save the settings and restart the router to apply changes.

Step 4: Optional Static Routing If you have multiple routers or devices behind your main router, you may need to configure static routes to ensure proper traffic flow. Enter the destination network, subnet mask, and gateway in the router's Static Routing section. This is especially important for multi-layer networks or when using multiple static IPs.

Step 5: Verify Configuration On a connected device, open a command prompt or terminal. Use `ipconfig` (Windows) or `ifconfig` (Linux/macOS) to confirm the router's WAN IP matches the static IP you con...
