Shared Wiring Practices

Neutral and Earth Lines: It is common and safe to share neutral and earth lines across multiple subcircuits within a distribution box. Neutrals are connected to a neutral busbar, and earth wires to an earth busbar, which then connect to the main earth pit. Shared neutrals must be carefully sized to handle the combined return current of all connected circuits to prevent overheating.

Phase (Live) Lines: Each subcircuit should ideally have its own phase line connected through an individual MCB. Sharing phase lines across multiple circuits is generally not recommended, as it can compromise overcurrent protection and make fault isolation difficult. For multi-room or high-power appliances, dedicated circuits with separate MCBs ensure safety and prevent nuisance tripping.

RCCB Considerations: Multiple circuits can be protected by a single RCCB, but care must be taken to ensure that the total leakage current does not exceed the RCCB rating. If circuits with high leakage currents (e.g., water heaters, air conditioners) are combined, it may cause unwanted tripping.
