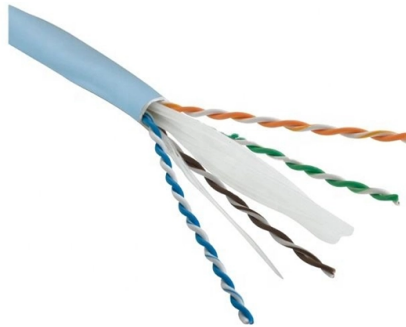


Simple T-junction construction for cable trays
