- Residential:** Typically 12–24 circuits, single-phase, flush or surface mounted.
- Commercial/Offices:** 24–42 circuits, may include lighting panels with dimming zones, single or three-phase.
- Industrial/Factories:** Large three-phase panels, motor control centers, or power distribution units, often with surge protection and remote monitoring.
