Installation Features Explosion-proof distribution boxes often include multiple cable entries with internal brass plates and Ex e plugs, allowing the use of metallic or polyamide ATEX cable glands. This flexibility enables adaptation to different cable sizes and project-specific requirements. Integrated load disconnect switches may be included for additional safety during maintenance. Safety Considerations Only matching ATEX-certified plugs and sockets should be used; mixing types is prohibited to maintain safety. The enclosure traps sparks inside, preventing ignition of the surrounding explosive atmosphere. Sockets are designed for permanent or mobile installations, with mobile units typically limited to lower currents (16–32A) and voltages (230–400V) depending on the application.
