- Routing and Switching:** Performs Layer 2 or Layer 3 switching, including inter-VLAN routing, access control, and load balancing, ensuring that voice and data packets are efficiently forwarded to the softswitch or core network.
- Quality of Service (QoS):** Prioritizes voice traffic over data to maintain call quality, reducing latency and jitter in VoIP communications.
- Redundancy and Failover:** Supports multiple uplinks and link aggregation to provide failover in case of a link failure, ensuring continuous connectivity for critical voice and data services.
- Integration with Softswitches:** Acts as a gateway for both wired and wireless users, forwarding signaling and media traffic to the softswitch while managing VLANs, IP addressing, and DHCP services.
