Components are arranged to ensure safe clearance, heat dissipation, and convenient wiring, often with metallic or heat-resistant insulating barriers between devices. Terminals can accept multiple conductor sizes, such as 3 x 2.5mm², 2 x 4mm², or 1 x 6mm². Mounting and Installation Distribution boxes can be wall-mounted, flush-mounted, or surface-mounted, with multiple cable entry points and knock-out holes for flexible installation. Mounting accessories typically include steel clips, screws, and brackets for secure attachment to trunking, conduits, or BESA boxes. Some boxes feature adjustable DIN rails for depth and horizontal alignment during installation.
