A distribution box is a low-voltage electrical enclosure that receives incoming power and distributes it safely to multiple outgoing circuits through protective and switching devices such as MCBs, RCDs, RCBOs, fuses, isolators, busbars, neutral bars, earth bars, and surge protective devices. The secondary unit substation is a close-coupled assembly consisting of enclosed primary high voltage equipment, three-phase power transformers, and enclosed secondary low-voltage equipment.
